## **DID YOU KNOW THAT?**

On Aug. 7, 2010 the BPAA reported that on World Record Day (Aug. 7, 2010)-the culmination of National Bowling Week (July 31-Aug. 7), the industry set a new record of most games played in a single day for the 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive year. Within 24 hours 923,948 games were played across the 1,252 centers that reported. A new benchmark for success for the sport we all love. Participation grew by 2.7% to over 71 million bowlers between April '09 and March 2010.

In the California USBC Open Championships in Bakersfield, local cashers in the Team Handicap Division were Tropical Tours Online, coming in 3<sup>rd</sup> place after shooting 2,778; and the Replacements in 9<sup>th</sup> place with a 2,715 series. Both teams are from Vacaville. Josh Bousley tied for second place in a singles handicap division with an 814 series & Benjamin Jones came in 5<sup>th</sup>, shooting 809.
